



Re-discovering Europe by feeling European citizens again.

European project co-financed by the European Union within the Programme Europe for Citizens – Network of Towns.

The project aims at creating a path of reflection and education to the European values, in order to promote the perception of the European Union as an 'Affair' of the citizens and not only a political-institutional entity. The project particularly involves youngsters. The foreseen activities also aim at reinforce the relations with the twinned town and to launch new cooperations with other European cities.

Started on 1st September 2018, the project lasts 2 years and aims at:

- sensitizing citizens and youngsters to the European values
- promoting a better knowledge of EU institutions and policies, as well as concrete rights and opportunities, creating a “European culture”
- making Europe more tangible and near to the citizens,
- giving value to the youth associations and informal groups dealing with EU issues

The project foreseen the realization of 7 transnational meetings and a lot of local activities aimed at actively involving the citizenship.

Due to Covid, the project has been postponed until 31/8/2022.
